**Description/Remarks**

This is a 1.5-story, 3-bay domestic building in the Craftsman style with Eclectic influences built in 1929. The structural system is frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original brick and original stucco. The building has a multi-plane cross gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with open cornice , exposed rafters. There is one side right, exterior, brick chimney. Windows are original wood, Prairie style grid/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, two-bay open porch characterized by a gabled roof clad in asphalt shingles with square brick posts.
