Description/Remarks

This is a 1-story, 3-bay domestic building in the Craftsman style built in 1925. The structural system is frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original wood siding. The building has a multi-plane cross gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with box cornice, brackets and two gabled dormers. There is one side right, exterior, brick chimney. Windows are original wood, Prairie style grid/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, single-bay open porch characterized by a gabled roof clad in asphalt shingles with battered wood posts on square brick piers.
