Description/Remarks

This is a 1-story, 2-bay domestic building in the Craftsman style built in 1925. The structural system is frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original wood siding and original wood shingles. The building has a multi-plane cross gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with open cornice , brackets. Windows are original wood, Prairie style grid/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, single-bay central open porch characterized by a gabled roof clad in asphalt shingles with battered wood posts on square stuccoed piers.
