Description/Remarks

This is a 2-story, 5-bay domestic building in the Georgian style with Eclectic influences built in 1925. The structural system is frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original brick. The building has a medium hip roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with box cornice. There is one offset left, front slope, brick chimney. Windows are original wood, 6/6 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, single-bay central open porch characterized by a flat with balcony roof with classical wood posts.
