**Description/Remarks**

This is a 1-story, 2-bay domestic building in the Craftsman style built in 1928. The structural system is frame. The foundation is piers. Exterior walls are original wood siding. The building has a multi-plane cross gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with open cornice, exposed rafters and brackets. Windows are original wood, Prairie style grid/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, single-bay open porch characterized by a gabled roof clad in asphalt shingles with battered wood posts on square brick piers.
