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Description/Remarks

This is a 1.5-story, multiple-bay domestic building in the Tudor style with English Cottage Revival influences built in 1928. The structural system is frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original brick. The building has a high front gable roof clad in original asbestos shingle with flush eaves. There is one off center in front chimney. Windows are original wood, multi-light paired casement. There is a single-story, single-bay enclosed porch characterized by an integrated (under the main) roof with arched brick posts.
