Description/Remarks

This is a 1-story, 2-bay domestic building in the Late Victorian style with Folk/Traditional influences built in 1915. The structural system is balloon frame. The foundation is piers. Exterior walls are original wood siding. The building has a pyramidal roof clad in original asbestos shingle with box cornice. Windows are original wood, 1/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, single-bay open porch characterized by a shed roof clad in asphalt shingles with battered wood posts on square brick piers. Alterations include a historic gable front wing.
