**Description/Remarks**

This is a 1-story, 3-bay domestic building in the Folk/Traditional style with Craftsman influences built in 1927. The structural system is frame. Exterior walls are original wood siding. The building has a high hip roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with open cornice , exposed rafters and brackets. Windows are replacement wood, horizontal 2/horizontal 2 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, two-bay open porch characterized by an integrated (under the main) roof with battered wood posts on square brick piers. An interesting mix of Folk massing and craftsman detailing.
