Description/Remarks

This is a 1.5-story, 3-bay domestic building in the Craftsman style built in 1921. The structural system is frame. The foundation is piers. Exterior walls are original wood siding. The building has a cross gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with open cornice , exposed rafters and brackets. Windows are original wood, vertical 5/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, three-quarter open porch characterized by a gabled roof with short battered wood posts on square brick piers.
