Description/Remarks

This is a 1-story, 3-bay domestic building in the Craftsman style with Shingle Style influences built in 1920. The structural system is frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original wood shingles. The building has a medium hip roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with raked box cornice. Windows are original wood, vertical 5-light paired casement. There is a single-story, single-bay open porch characterized by a hip roof clad in asphalt shingles with round wood posts.
