Description/Remarks

This is a 1.5-story, 4-bay domestic building in the Late Victorian style with Queen Anne influences built in 1899. The structural system is frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original wood siding. The building has a multi-plane/complex roof clad in replacement wood shingles with box cornice and one gabled dormer. Windows are original wood, 1/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, wrap-around open porch characterized by a shed roof clad in wood shingles with square wood posts on square brick piers.
