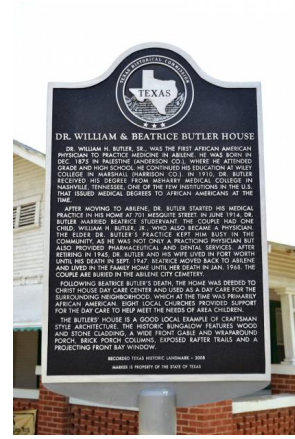

Description/Remarks

This is a 1-story, 2-bay domestic building in the Craftsman style built in 1925. The structural system is frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original brick and original wood siding. The building has a hip and gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with open cornice , exposed rafters. Windows are original wood double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, three-quarter open porch characterized by a gabled roof clad in asphalt shingles with paired wood posts on square brick piers.
