Description/Remarks

This is a 2-story, 5-bay domestic building in the Colonial Revival style with Georgian influences built in 1935. The structural system is undetermined. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original brick. The building has a low side gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with box cornice and two gabled dormers. There is one side left, exterior, brick chimney. Windows are original wood, 9/9 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, single-bay platform/stoop characterized by a flat roof with turned wood posts.
