Description/Remarks

This is a 2-story, 3-bay domestic building in the Craftsman style with Prairie School influences built in 1920. The structural system is frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original stucco. The building has a low hip roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with box cornice. Windows are original wood, vertical 4/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, wrap-around open porch characterized by a bellcast gable roof clad in asphalt shingles with battered wood posts on square stuccoed piers.
