This is a 1-story, 3-bay domestic building in the Craftsman style built in 1921. The structural system is frame. The foundation is piers. Exterior walls are original stucco. The building has a cross gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with open cornice , exposed rafters and brackets. Windows are original wood, 1/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, corner wrap-around open porch characterized by a gabled roof clad in asphalt shingles with square stuccoed posts.
