Description/Remarks

This is a 2-story, 3-bay domestic building in the Eclectic style with Romanesque Revival influences built in 1942. The structural system is undetermined. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original brick. The building has a bellcast hip roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles. Windows are original wood, 4/1 double-hung sashes. There is a two-story, single-bay rooftop terrace characterized by a flat roof with arched brick posts.
