Description/Remarks

This is a 1.5-story, 3-bay domestic building in the Craftsman style with Colonial Revival influences built in 1915. The structural system is frame. The foundation is piers. Exterior walls are original wood siding. The building has a pyramidal roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles and one hip-roofed dormer. There is one offset left, brick chimney. Windows are original wood, Vertical 6/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, full-span open porch characterized by an integrated (under the main) roof with classical wood posts.
