**Description/Remarks**

This is a 1.5-story, 13-bay commercial building in the Mission/Spanish Revival style with Late Victorian influences built in 1910. The structural system is wood platform. The foundation is poured concrete. Exterior walls are original brick veneer and original brick veneer. The building has a multi-plane/complex roof clad in original terra-cotta tiles. Windows are original wood, 1/1 double-hung sashes. Underwent significant restoration
