Description/Remarks

This is a 1-story, 3-bay commercial building in the Italianate style with 20th Century Commercial influences built in 1935. The structural system is steel frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original brick. The building has a high hip roof clad in replacement pressed/patterned metal with box cornice , eave brackets. Windows are original wood, multi/1 operable transom. Completely restored.
