Description/Remarks

This is a 2-story, 2-bay commercial building in the Art Deco style with Art Moderne influences built in 1925. The structural system is undetermined. Exterior walls are original brick. The building has a flat roof. Windows are original wood, 1/1 double-hung sashes. One of the earliest examples of a service station for Abilene and located along the historic route of the Bankhead Highway. Now houses a retail establishment.
