This is a 2.5-story, 3-bay commercial building in the Beaux Arts/Neo-Classical style built in 1909. The structural system is frame. Exterior walls are original brick. The building has a flat with parapet roof. Windows are original wood, 3/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, single-bay portico characterized by a flat roof clad in an undetermined material with paired wood posts.
