**Description/Remarks**

This is a 2-story, 4-bay commercial building in the Mid-Century Modern style with Modern Movement influences built in 1950. The structural system is steel frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original stone veneer and original synthetic panels. The building has a flat roof. Windows are original aluminum, horizontal 3-light louvered. This was non-contributing at the time of the National Register Nomination, but would be eligible by today's criteria.
