Description/Remarks

This is a 2.5-story, 2-bay domestic building in the Tudor style built in 1930. The structural system is frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original brick. The building has a cross gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with flush eaves. There is one off center in front, exterior, brick chimney. Windows are original wood, 6/6 double-hung sashes. There is a platform/stoop. Very large addition on the eastern side that could potentially be removed. It is very evidently a later addition.
