**Description/Remarks**

This is a 1-story, 1-bay domestic building in the Craftsman style built in 1920. The structural system is frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original wood siding. The building has a medium front gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with raked open cornice , exposed rafters and brackets. Windows are original wood, 12/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, full-span open porch characterized by a gabled roof with square wood posts.
