**Description/Remarks**

This is a 2-story, 3-bay domestic building in the Prairie School style built in 1921. The structural system is frame. Exterior walls are stucco. The building has a low hip roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with box cornice , eave brackets. There is one side left, exterior chimney. Windows are original wood, 9/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, two-bay open porch characterized by a flat with balcony roof with square stuccoed posts. This 1901 House was moved to this property by Dr. Alexander in 1921 and converted to Prairie Style.
