Description/Remarks

This is a 2-story, 4-bay domestic building in the Colonial Revival style built in 1910. The structural system is frame. Exterior walls are original wood siding. The building has a gambrel roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with flush eaves and three shed-roofed dormers. Windows are original wood, 1/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, full-span open porch characterized by a hip roof clad in asphalt shingles with round wood posts.
