## Description/Remarks

This is a 1-story, 4-bay domestic building in the Craftsman style built in 1925. The structural system is undetermined. The foundation is piers. Exterior walls are original stucco and original wood siding. The building has a low side gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles. There is one center, straddle ridge, stuccoed chimney. Windows are original wood, vertical 4/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, two-bay open porch characterized by a gabled roof clad in asphalt shingles with short battered wood posts on battered stuccoed piers.
