This is a 1-story, 2-bay domestic building in the No Primary Style with Craftsman influences built in 1930. The structural system is undetermined. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original wood siding. The building has a medium front gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles. Windows are original wood, 1/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, single-bay corner porch characterized by an integrated (under the main) roof with decorative metal posts.
