Description/Remarks

This is a 1-story, 5-bay domestic building in the Tudor style with Eclectic influences built in 1935. The structural system is frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original brick. The building has a multi-plane front gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with box cornice. There is one off center in front, exterior, brick chimney. Windows are original wood, 1/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, three-bay open porch characterized by a gabled roof clad in asphalt shingles with arcaded arch brick posts.
