Description/Remarks

This is a 1.5-story, 3-bay domestic building in the Queen Anne style with Classical Revival influences built in 1907. The structural system is frame. The foundation is piers. Exterior walls are original wood siding and original wood shingles. The building has a multi-plane/complex roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with box cornice. Windows are original wood, 1/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, wrap-around open porch characterized by a shed roof clad in asphalt shingles with classical wood posts.
