**Description/Remarks**

This is a 1.5-story, multiple-bay domestic building in the Craftsman style with Prairie School influences built in 1917. The structural system is frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original brick and original wood siding. The building has a low side gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with open cornice, exposed rafters and brackets and two gabled dormers. There is one offset left, front slope, brick chimney. Windows are original wood, vertical 5/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, single-bay open porch characterized by a gabled roof clad in asphalt shingles with square brick posts.
