The building has a low hip roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with box cornice, corbelling and one hip-roofed dormer. There is one side left, exterior, brick chimney. Windows are original wood, 9/1 double-hung sashes. There is a full-span open porch characterized by a hip roof clad in asphalt shingles with square brick posts.
