Description/Remarks

This is a 1-story, 2-bay domestic building in the Late Victorian style with Folk/Traditional influences built in 1920. The structural system is frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original wood siding. The building has a bellcast hip roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with box cornice. Windows are replacement vinyl, 6/6 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, single-bay open porch characterized by a hip roof clad in asphalt shingles with turned wood posts.
