**Description/Remarks**

This is a 1-story, 3-bay domestic building in the English Cottage Revival style with Tudor influences built in 1927. The structural system is frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original wood siding. The building has a hipped gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with flush eaves. There is one off center in front, exterior, brick chimney. Windows are original wood, 4/4 double-hung sashes. There is a single-bay platform/stoop.
