**Description/Remarks**

This is a 2-story, 4-bay domestic building in the English Cottage Revival style with Tudor influences built in 1930. The structural system is frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original brick and original wood siding. The building has a gambrel roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles. There is one side right, exterior, brick chimney. Windows are original wood, 6/6 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, single-bay open porch characterized by a hip roof clad in asphalt shingles with square brick posts.
