Description/Remarks

This is a 1-story, 2-bay domestic building in the Craftsman style with Folk/Traditional influences built in 1925. The structural system is frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original stone veneer and original board and batten. The building has a multi-plane cross gable roof clad in replacement standing seam metal with open cornice, gable brackets. There is one side right, exterior, stone chimney. Windows are original wood, vertical 3/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, single-bay open porch characterized by a gabled roof clad in standing seam metal with battered wood posts on square stone piers. Front door and a front window have been closed with cinder block.
