Description/Remarks

This is a 3-story, 3-bay commercial building in the Gothic/Neo-Gothic style with 20th Century Commercial influences built in the period 1920-1929. The structural system is balloon frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original stone. The building has a flat with parapet roof. Windows are original wood, multi/multi grouped dh sash. The second floor windows were filled in in the 1950's. The current owner plans to restore these windows to the original condition.
