Description/Remarks

This is a 1-story, 3-bay domestic building in the Mission/Spanish Revival style built in 1945. The structural system is frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original brick. The building has a cross gable roof clad in original terra cotta barrel tile with flush eaves. Windows are original wood, multi-light casements. There is a single-story, single-bay central veranda characterized by a shed roof clad in terra-cotta tiles with arcaded arch brick posts.
