Description/Remarks

This is a 10-story, multiple-bay commercial building in the Beaux Arts/Neo-Classical style built in 1927. The structural system is steel frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original brick. The building has a flat roof. Windows are replacement steel, 1/1 double-hung sashes. Leased to Conrad Hilton in 1927, this was the first hotel to bear the Hilton name. It was later renamed the Windsor when the Hilton lease ran out in 1945. The current use is elderly apartments.
