Description/Remarks

This is a 2-story, 3-bay domestic building in the Prairie School style built in 1928. The structural system is frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original brick. The building has a low hip roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with box cornice and one hip-roofed dormer. There is one side left, exterior, brick chimney. Windows are original wood, Prairie style grid/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, full-span rooftop terrace characterized by a flat roof with paired brick posts.
