**Description/Remarks**

This is a 1.5-story, 3-bay domestic building in the Craftsman style built in 1920. The structural system is frame. The foundation is piers. Exterior walls are original brick and original wood siding. The building has a cross gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with open cornice , exposed rafters and brackets. Windows are original wood, 9/9 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, three-quarter open porch characterized by a gabled roof clad in asphalt shingles with square brick posts.
