Description/Remarks

This is a 1.5-story, 3-bay domestic building in the Late Victorian style with Folk/Traditional influences built in 1905. The structural system is frame. The foundation is piers. Exterior walls are original wood siding. The building has a cross gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with flush eaves and one gabled dormer. Windows are replacement vinyl, 1/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, two-bay open porch characterized by a shed roof clad in asphalt shingles with round wood posts.
