**Description/Remarks**

This is a 1-story, 3-bay domestic building in the Craftsman style built in 1920. The structural system is frame. The foundation is piers. Exterior walls are original brick and original stucco. The building has a hip and gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with raked open cornice. There is one side right, exterior, brick chimney. Windows are original wood, Chicago-light casements. There is a single-story, single-bay open porch characterized by a gabled roof clad in asphalt shingles with battered wood posts on square brick piers.
