**Description/Remarks**

This is a 2-story, multiple-bay domestic building in the Mission/Spanish Revival style built in 1928. The structural system is frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original stucco. The building has a flat with parapet roof clad in replacement synthetic barrel tile asphalt with flush eaves. Windows are original wood, 1/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, three-quarter enclosed porch characterized by a flat roof clad in pressed/patterned metal with arcaded arch stuccoed posts.
