This is a 1-story, 3-bay domestic building in the Folk/Traditional style built in 1920. The structural system is balloon frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original wood siding. The building has a high hip roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles. Windows are replacement aluminum, 1/1 double-hung sashes. There is a two-bay open porch characterized by an integrated (under the main) roof with square metal posts.
