Description/Remarks

This is a 1.5-story, 3-bay domestic building in the Late Victorian style with Craftsman influences built in 1908. The structural system is frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original wood paneling. The building has a bellcast gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with raked open cornice , exposed rafters and brackets and one shed-roofed dormer. There is one center, front slope chimney. Windows are original wood, vertical 4/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, full-span open porch characterized by an integrated (under the main) roof with paired wood posts on square brick piers. Possibly a kit home that has historic modifications dating from 1908-1925. The wood siding has been routed to resemble brick.
