Description/Remarks

This is a 1-story, 4-bay domestic building in the Bungalow/craftsman style built in 1919. The structural system is frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original wood siding. The building has a multi-plane front gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with raked open cornice , gable brackets. There is one offset left, side slope, brick chimney. Windows are original wood, 6/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, three-quarter open porch characterized by a gabled roof clad in asphalt shingles with square wood posts on square brick piers.
