Description/Remarks

This is a 1.5-story, 4-bay domestic building in the Tudor style built in 1930. The structural system is frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original stucco. The building has a multi-plane/complex roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with box cornice and one shed-roofed dormer. There is one off center in front, exterior, stuccoed chimney. Windows are original wood, 4/4 grouped dh sash. There is a platform/stoop.
