Description/Remarks

This is a 2-story, 3-bay domestic building in the Eclectic style with Craftsman influences built in 1930. The structural system is frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original brick. The building has a multi-plane front gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with box cornice. There is one side left, exterior, brick chimney. Windows are original wood, 1/1 grouped double-hung sash. There is a single-story, single-bay open porch characterized by a gabled roof clad in asphalt shingles with square brick posts.
