Description/Remarks

This is a 1-story, 3-bay domestic building in the Craftsman style built in 1925. The structural system is frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original stone and original stucco. The building has a multi-plane front gable roof clad in replacement standing seam metal with box cornice. Windows are original wood, vertical 3/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-bay open porch characterized by a gable with arch roof clad in standing seam metal with arched brick posts.
